CORUNNA—Word came to Attorney Homer Bush on Friday of the sudden death of his brother, Russell A. Bush, of Detroit, who, with his wife, was vacationing in New York City in celebration of their 10th wedding anniversary.

Death was due to a heart attack. The remains were flown from New York and services were held today at 1 o'clock from the Hamilton Funeral Home in Detroit.
