CORUNNA - Harold Ellsworth Sanders, formerly of Caledonia Township and Corunna, died April 25 in a hospital in Warren. Mr. Sanders was 74.

Funeral services were held in St. Anne's Parish of Warren on April 28 with burial in the Holy Sepulchre in Southfield.

Mr. Sanders was born Dec. 15, 1899, the son of Ellsworth and Maud (Hawkins) Sanders. He graduated from Corunna High School and served in the United States Navy during World War I aboard the U. S. S. Alabama and Eastern Queen. He was released from the Navy in 1921.
