Donald G. Dutcher, 57, of 5311 S. Morrice Rd., died Sunday about 1:30 a.m. of a self-inflicted gunshot wound.

Coroner Howard Jennings ruled the death a suicide. Dutcher shot himself in the head with a 16-gauge shotgun.

The body was found about 7 a.m. behind a shed by Dutcher's son, Allen, who resides on the same farm.

Mrs. Dutcher told sheriff's deputies that she and her husband came home from a wedding reception about 1 a.m. Sunday. She said she went to bed but her husband stayed up. She awoke at about 6:45 a.m. and saw that her husband hadn't been to bed. She called her son who began scarching for him and soon found the body. deputies said.

Funeral services are to be held at 2 p.m. Tuesday at Kribs Funeral Home with Elder Walter A. Hoag officiating. Burial will be in Pine Tree Cemetery.

Mr Dutcher was born in Stockbridge Nov. 18, 1910, the son of Randall R. and Roberta Dutcher. He attended Corunna High School.

He held degrees from Cleveland Bible Institute (now Malone College), John Fletcher College, and the University of Iowa (MA and PhD). He did graduate studies in several seminaries. He was ordained in The Evangelical United Brethren Church, which today is part of The United Methodist Church in which he held ministerial credentials. He served pastorates in Iowa and Michigan, and as an evangelist throughout the United States and Canada. Dr. Rose was co-founder of Western Evangelical Seminary (now merged with George Fox University of Newberg, OR) and of Wesley Biblical Seminary (Jackson, MS). He also taught at Asbury Theological Seminary (Wilmore, KY) for 23 years. He authored Vital Holiness:?áA Theology of Christian Experience, as well as Bible study quides, along with numerous contributions to religious journals and magazines. In 1936, Delbert married Dorothy Walter of Owosso, MI. She passed away on July 24, 1985. They had four children. Delbert, is survived by three children: Daniel (married to Martha Denmead and living in Philadelphia, PA), Marilyn (married to Ron Smiley and living in Seaside, OR), and W. David (Ft. Myers, FL) as well as 4 grandchildren: Jeff Smiley, married to Alison and living in Issaguah, WA, with their children Luke, Madison and Jack; Julianne Smiley Spaulding, married to Tad and living in Fishers, IN, with their children Alex, Makenzie, Morgan, Chloe, Noah and Landon; Meredith Rose, married to Adam Fries of CO, with their children Sol and Diego Emma Rose, married to Neil Geyette, with their daughter Lucia, of Philadelphia, PA.
