


All cremation arrangements were made under the direction of Stockdale Funeral Services of Rogers, Ark.



Mr. Crowe was a licensed livestock dealer, was in livestock trucking and farming.



Don enjoyed bird and deer watching, hunting, fishing and carpentry. He found his greatest joy spending time with his family and his dogs Cinder and Chelsea.





Upon graduation from Corunna High School in 1953, she married Don Washburn, who passed away in 1983.




