# County Road Commissioner Vic Nickels Dies

Victor D. Nickela, who was recently re-elected to the Shiawassee Board of County Road Commissioners, died Sunday afternoon of an apparent heart attack while hunting in Burns Township.

As a memorial tribute to Nickels, the Shiawassee County Road Commission will be closed on Wednesday.

day.
Nickels, 50, of Durand, was hunting with his son Don near Beard Road when he reportedly suffered a heart attack around 2 p.m. He was taken to Flint Osteopathic Hospital, where he was pronounced dead on arrival.

The Shiawassee County native ran unchallenged on the Democratic ticket in the Nov. 8 election and received 15,994 votes on his way to a second six-year term on the road board. He had also faced no opposition in the August primary election.

During his first term on the board, Nickels served as vice chairman in 1985 and as chairman since 1986.

It will be up to the Shiawassee County Board of Commissioners to appoint an interim replacement until the next general election.

"I'm surprised and very disappointed," said Road Commission Superintendent/Manager Walter Clink.

"He worked hard and he played hard," Clink recalled. "He was very helpful with labor-related matters, and was conscientious about answering complaints from the public. He was very knowledgeable about machinery, he knew a lot of people in the county, and he was well-known."

Nickels was a supervisor with Agersinger and Morse Construction Co. He had 30 years of experience in road construction — 25 years in supervision.

A 1957 graduate of Corunna High School, he was a 20-year member of the Owosso Engles Aerie #851, and also belonged to the Owosso Bowling Association, Corunna Lions Club and Corunna Jaycees.

He was a veteran of the U.S. Army, having attained the rank of Sergeant.

Nickels was born Sept. 13, 1938 in Durand, son of Harry and Rose (Jankowski) Nickels.

He is survived by his wife Nancy (North). They were married on April 4, 1964 in Bancroft and they have three grown children — Don of Durand, Teresa of Boca Raton, Fla., and Kim of Owosso.


The road board is comprised of three elected officials, with staggered six-year terms. The other two elected officials are Warden E. Garber and John H. Conger, both of Owesso.
