Sharon looked forward to time spent with family and friends. She will be remembered by her loved ones for her love of mystery shows and jigsaw puzzles.


Sharon married Glenn Jandik in Owosso on May 2, 1964.

She was predeceased by her parents and many aunts, uncles and cousins.



He graduated from Corunna High School, class of 1959 and attended Devry Institute in Chicago.


Mark was a member of the First Free Methodist Church where he had served as Sunday School Superintendent, Moose Lodge of Durand and a past member of the Lions Club.
