John was born Nov. 4, 1946, in Perry, the son of Dolph and Edna (Dibble) Fuller.


He graduated from Corunna High School, class of 1964; he then went on to further his education at Michigan State University where he received his associate's degree.


Jim was a dairy farmer and later worked for Meijer.

John was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church. He married Alice Louise Murphy April 26, 1969, at St. Paul Catholic Church.




Jim married Mary Stewart in 1986 on Mackinac Island; she predeceased him in March of 2000.

Dick married Marjorie Hillis (Rasmussen) on Jan. 30, 1971, in Moscow, Idaho.


