Rhonda died suddenly and very unexpectedly. The cause was a catastrophic cardiovascular event. Her passing occurred just nine days after the death of David Dawson, her loving partner of 20 years.

Born into the post World War II Baby Boom, she was the first born of five children to Ralph C. Chapin, a World War II Army Veteran and his Australian born war bride Cecilia V. Chapin. She was born in Ann Arbor, while her father was in dental school at the University of Michigan.

In 1949, the young family moved to Corunna, where Rhonda attended public school. She graduated with the class of 1965. She was a high achiever, belonging to the National Honor Society, and Student Council. She was a popular cheerleader, and was elected to the homecoming queen's court. She remained in touch with life long friends and class mates over the years.

Rhonda attended the University of Michigan from the fall of 1965 to December of 1967, when she left to marry her steady boyfriend Gregory Towne. He had just enlisted in the Navy to avoid being drafted during the Vietnam war. During their four years of Navy life, they moved many times, to ports in Connecticut, Mississippi, Key West, California and Hawaii.

Later, both Rhonda and Greg returned to the University of Michigan to complete their educations. In 1973, Rhonda earned a bachelor of science degree in Biology, and Greg earned a degree in Civil Engineering.

Of all the places they had lived, they both liked sunny California the best. So they moved to California to begin their careers. In San Diego, they made many friends through sailing their 32 foot Catalina, named the Chrysalis.

Although her enthusiasm for



California lasted, her marriage to Greg did not.

That was when she began her career in the Bio-Tech industry, beginning with Calbiochem-Behring Diagnostics. Over the years she also worked at Beckman Instruments Inc., Cholestech Corp., Syngene Inc., Genprobe Inc. and for the last 21 years, at Vical Inc. where she had attained the position of Assistant Director of Quality Control.

Rhonda was predeceased by her father Ralph C. Chapin D.D.S. and her partner of 20 years David Dawson.

She is survived by her mother Cecilia V. Chapin; sisters Alicia Forsman and Marcia Quast; brothers John Chapin and Charles Chapin; nephew Stephen Quast; nieces Allison Lents and Stacey Quast; and grand niece Olivia Lents.

At Corunna High School, Ed was known as a class clown.

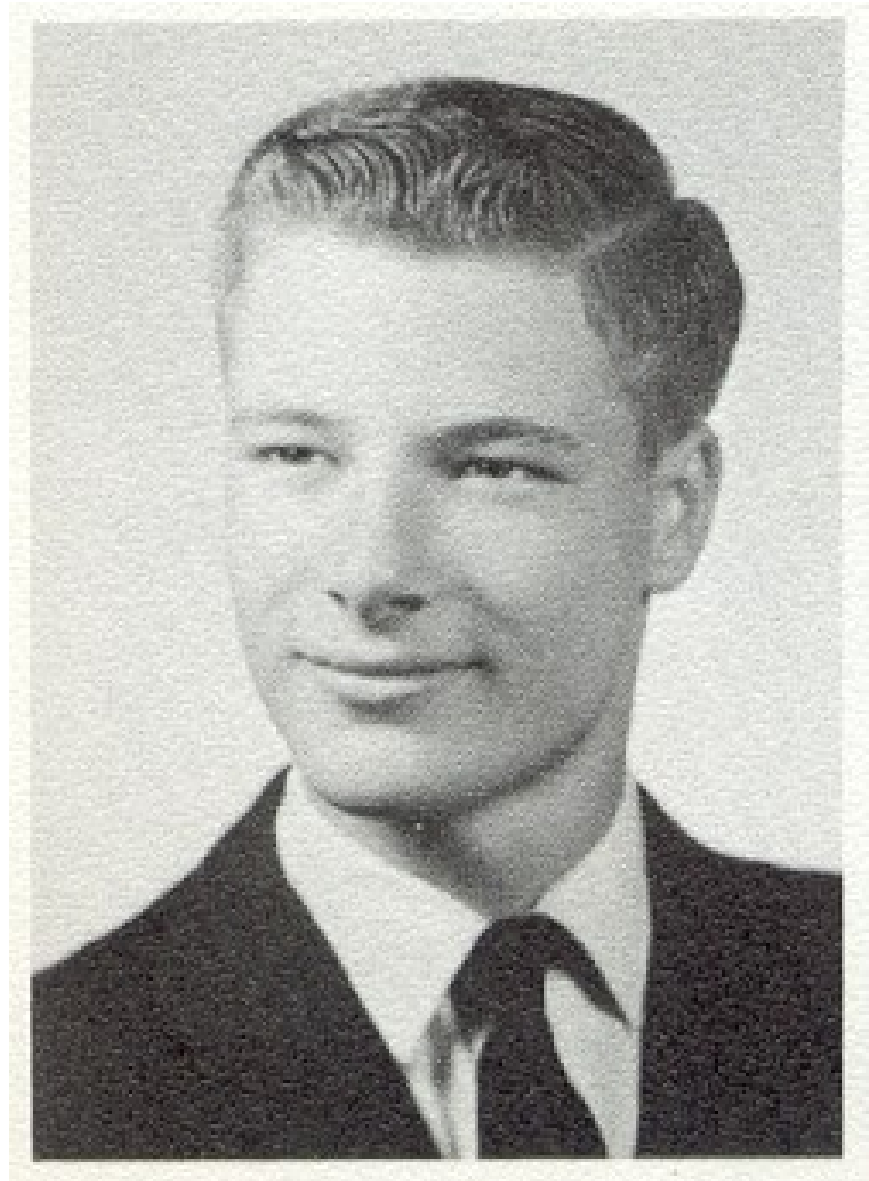
After graduating in 1965, he enlisted in the U.S. Air Force and was assigned to Anderson Air Force Base, Guam, as an Air Traffic Controller. Following this tour of duty, Ed volunteered for service in Vietnam. He was assigned to 8th Aerial Port Squadron's Mobility Team, and spent much time as a member of the "Dirty Dozen," at Song Be, near the Cambodian border. After recuperating from wounds in a military hospital in Japan, Ed returned to Vietnam and was recruited by Military Assistance Command-Vietnam- Studies and Observation Group. With this group, he operated on classified missions in Laos, Cambodia and Burma. He was honorably discharged in 1968 with the rank of Staff Sergeant.

He is perhaps mostly known for his writing of novels, short stories and poetry, particularly the critically acclaimed "DAU: A Novel of Vietnam," which was published internationally. Ed was a member of Amnesty International, Vietnam Veterans of America for a Landmine Free World, the American Leprosy Mission, and a life-time member of Disabled American Veterans, Chapter 5, Los Angeles. Through Children International, he sponsored Sukanda in Thailand, Julie and Arlyn in the Philippines, Bapan in Calcutta, Racheal in Zambia, Juan in Ecuador, and David in Columbia. He had attended Los Angeles City College, Hollywood Branch. Ed was quietly proud of his sobriety, which began in 1985. He came to understand that God was sufficient for all of his needs.

Survivors include his former wife Rose Doyle Nohel of Morrice; daughter Shannon Joy (Troy) Thielen of Lansing; son Zachary Edward Dodge of Lansing; grandson Andrew J. Thielen; father George E. Single Vehicle Accident Claims Life of Local Man

CORUNNA- A 29-year-old rural Corunna man was killed early today when the van he was driving went out of control on North McKay Road at the Cronk Road intersection, skidded into a ditch and rolled over one time.

Shiawassee County Sheriff's deputies identified the man as John William Holzhausen, 5563 N. Cram Rd., Venice Twp. He was pronounced dead at the scene of the approximately 2 a.m. accident by Shiawassee County Medical Examiner Dr. J.G. Lyons.

Deputies said Holzhausen travelled approximately 62 total feet from the time he entered the ditch until the van came to rest rightside up at the intersection.

An autopsy was scheduled for today. Deputies said an investigation would continue to determine, if possible, the cause of the tragedy.

Deputies said James Adkins, 3170 N. Vernon Rd., reported the accident at approximately 1:40 a.m. Adkins told deputies he had been through the same intersection at midnight and all was clear.

The location is in an unpopulated farming area and deputies said it is, at this point, impossible to tell how long Holzhausen had been lying in the wreckage between midnight and 1:40 a.m.

Holzhausen is the fourth traffic fatality this year in Shiawassee County.

To date 639 persons have died on Michigan roads and highways. Last year at this time the death toll was 699.

This month throughout the state 80 persons have lost their lives in traffic accidents.

Funeral services will be held Monday at 11 a.m. from Jennings-Lyons Chapel with burial in Hillcrest Memorial Gardens. The Rev. Ronald D. Thacker is to officiate.

Mr. Holzhausen was born March 20, 1946 in Owosso, son of George and Irene (Early) Holzhausen. He attended schools at Six Mile Creek, New Haven Township, and graduated from Corunna High School in 1965. He had resided in the New Haven and Shiawassee Townships all of his life.

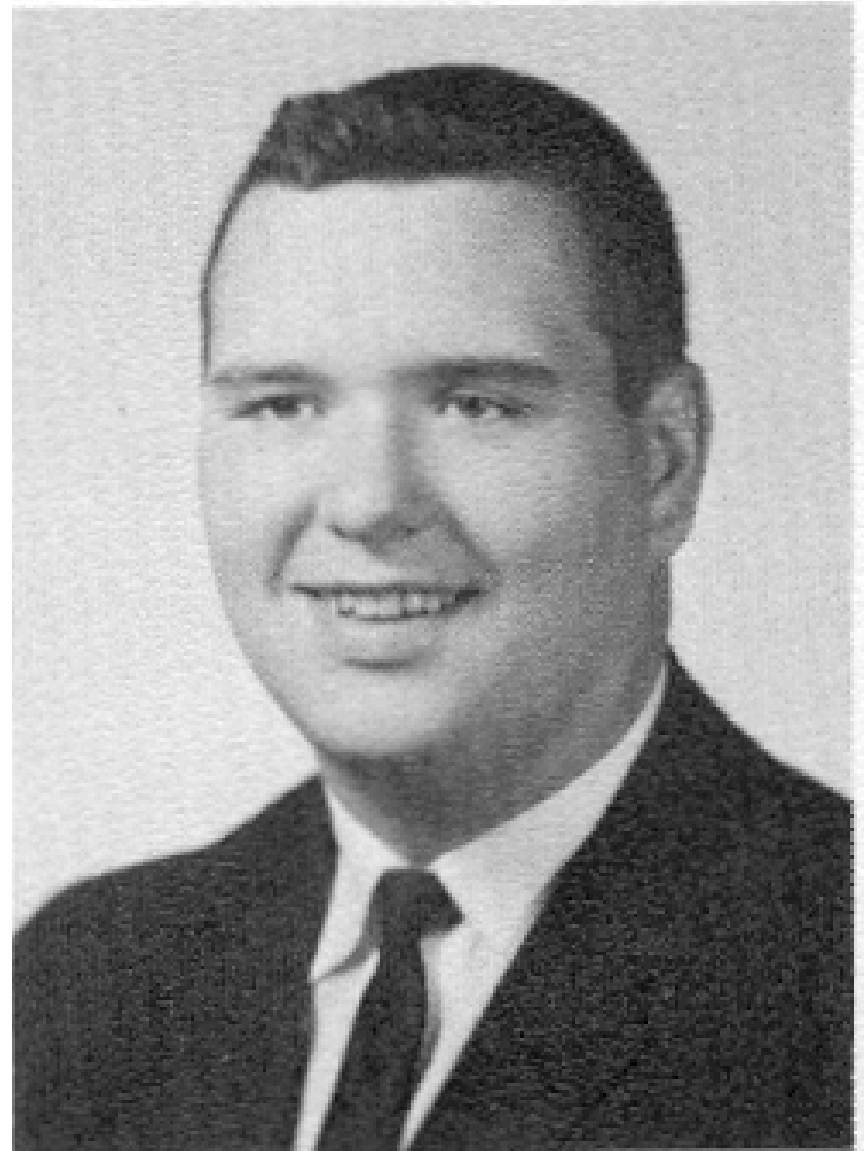

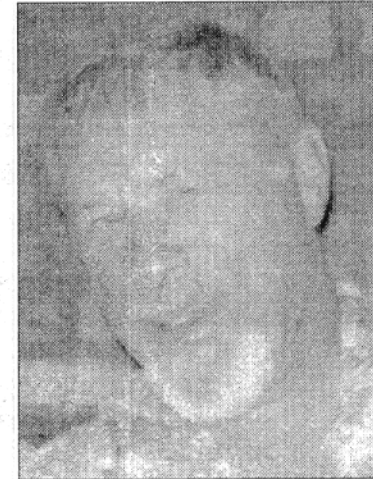
Robert was born June 16, 1947, in Vernon, the son of Merwin and Mildred (Aldrich) Merrill.
