Those who have passed before him are his parents, Dick and Hazel Jones; a brother, Bill Jones; and his mother-in-law, Ella Beckwith.

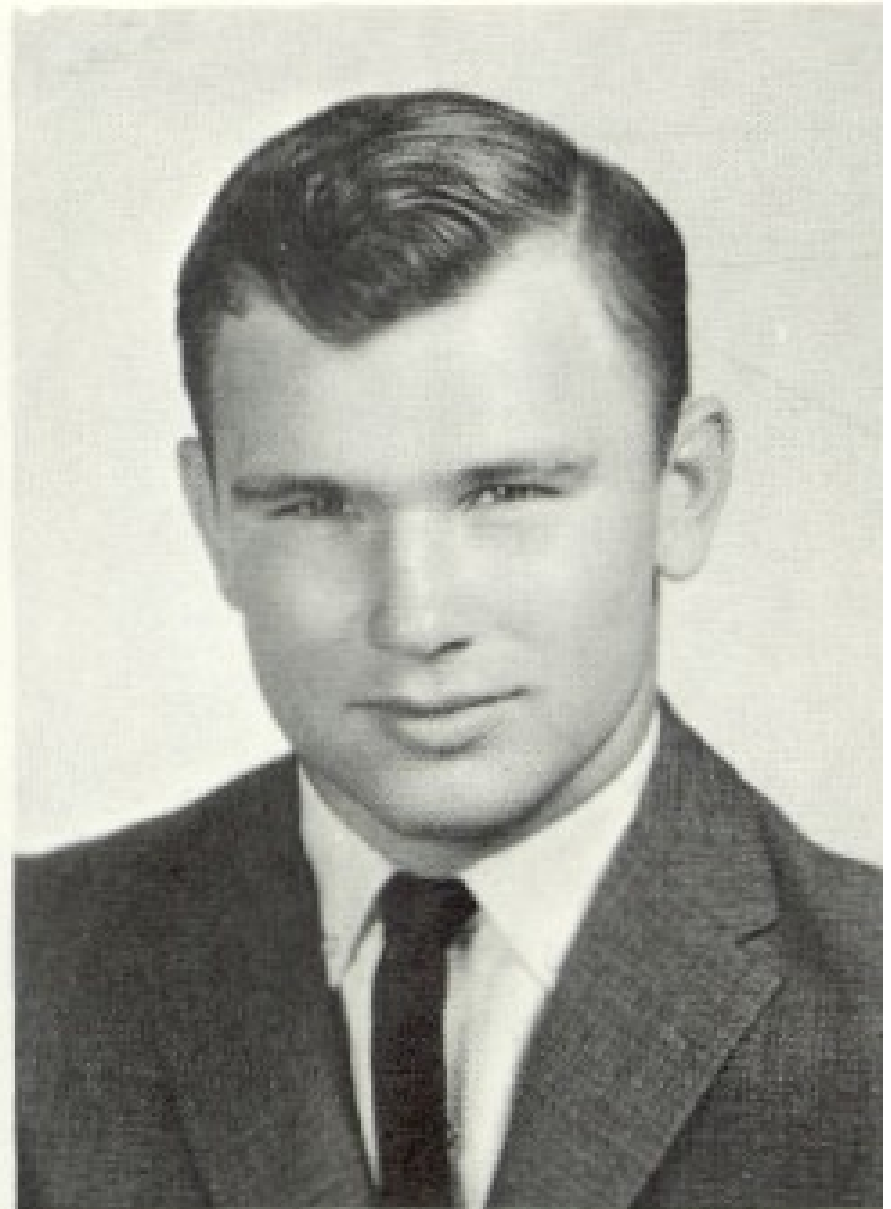

He was predeceased by his parents.

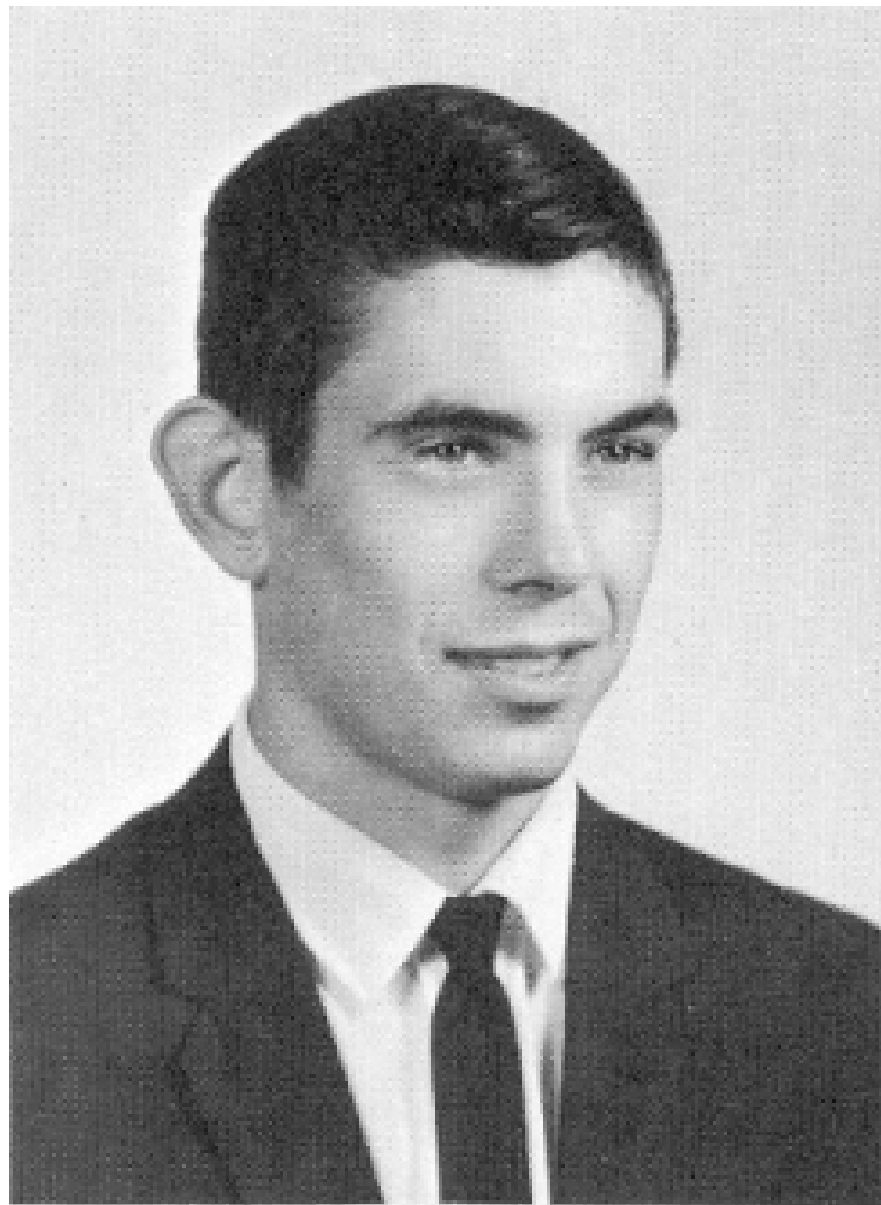
